SCHENGEN VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR CREW ON PRIVATE VESSELS

Detailed below are the requirements for the seaman's visa to board private vessels in the Schengen Area. This Consular Section issues this visa to <u>Jamaican citizens living in Jamaica</u> and <u>other nationals</u> <u>with legal residence in Jamaica</u> who will board in one of the following Schengen States: **Spain**, **Austria**, **France**, **Greece**, **Hungary**, **Latvia**, **Malta**, **Poland**, **Portugal**, **Slovenia**, **The Czech Republic** and **The Slovak Republic**.

- 1. Schengen visa application form, duly completed and signed
- 2. One recent passport photograph
- 3. Valid passport
- 4. Seaman's Passbook
- 5. Work Contract
- 6. Crew List
- 7. Registration of the vessel
- 8. Medical Health Insurance in the name of the crew member with expiration date
- 9. Itinerary of approximate dates the yacht will be in the Schengen area
- 10. Flight details
- 11. Visa or permit if not resident in the country where crew member will embark

IMPORTANT!

- Applicants will be required to schedule an appointment for the submission of visa applications at this Consular Section, the instructions for which are outlined on the Embassy's website.
- Visa fee of JMD 15,121.00 is to be paid in cash upon submission of application
- Processing time is 5 calendar days.
- Applications may be submitted within 180 days of arrival date in the Schengen Area, no earlier.
- NO firearms or weapons allowed! Persons carrying firearms or weapons will NOT be permitted entry.
