<u>Subject:</u> Secondment of two national experts to the General Secretariat of the European Parliament, DG SAFE - Directorate for Technologies and Information, Information Security and Analysis Unit

Dear Sir/Madam.

The Directorate for Technologies and Information in the Directorate General for Security and Safety of the European Parliament seeks an expert that will work in the area of prevention and countering of foreign interference, and other security threats.

The duration of the secondment is two years with the possibility of an extension to a maximum of four years in total. In exceptional cases, this secondment could be extended for an additional period of up to two years.

The candidate selected would take up duties at the General Secretariat of the European Parliament foreseeably by 1st April 2026. The qualifications and experience required are set out in the Annex to this letter.

I hereby would like to invite Member States' Permanent Representations to propose candidates qualified for this post. I would be grateful if the proposals could indicate the national contact point(s) responsible for each candidate's submission. Submissions must be accompanied by a letter of motivation and a CV providing details of education and all posts held hitherto by the candidate.

The Directorate for Technologies and Information, together with the Human Resources Unit, will examine the applications received, establish a shortlist of candidates and conduct the interviews.

The names of the candidates to be proposed for these secondments will be agreed following an exchange with the Office of the Permanent Representative of the Member State concerned.
